Rules

This contest is open to all members and nonmembers, regardless of skill level or past winnings.

All competitors must wear protective eye wear in all of the classes.

No power tools will be allowed in any class.

The judge will have the final say on all any questions not covered in these rules.

NOTE: The ESF requires that each competitor must have a fire extinguisher that has a minimum rating of 2-A 10 BC. All propane tanks must be secured so they cannot tip or fall . These precautions must be in place prior to the beginning of the competition. The fire marshal will be inspecting your equipment to see that it meets the requirements. If you have not met these requirements your entry fees will be forfeit and you are not eligible to compete until you have rectified the situation.
